 DIRECTIONS FROM THE M6  
 Leave at Junction 13 and take the A449 towards Stafford. At the first island take the third exit signposted for Acton Trussell, cross the canal bridge and bear right through the village. The Moat House is at the far end of the village close to the Church.  
 FROM THE A34  
 At Brocton Crossroads (on the Stafford side of the Chetwynd Arms Public House) turn towards Penkridge, take the fourth turning right and The Moat House is on your left.  
 FROM PENKRIDGE/A449  
 At the island in the centre of Penkridge turn towards Brocton. Continue along this road for 2 1/2 miles after crossing the canal take the first turning left. The Moat House is then on your left.
